### **Welcome to the Gallery!**

The Crescent Harbor Gallery is owned and operated by the nonprofit Coast Redwoods Art Association. Our mission is to promote art in the community.

### **Membership**

Dues of \$40 for a single person or \$45 for a family are paid in January. Please be prompt.

### **Meetings/Art Demo**

There is a Business meeting the third Thursday of each month at the gallery at 11:00 a.m. You are encouraged to attend and may offer any input you feel is necessary. Our social is the 4th Thursday of each month at 11:00 a.m. Members attending are encouraged to bring a finger food. The Art Demo starts at noon by an accomplished artist. This is a good time to make friends, find out more about your media or a new media, and enjoy being a part of the gallery. (No Demo's Nov, & Dec).

### **Newsletter**

This is delivered to you by mail or email every month. It will be full of local news and other information, so please read it! If you have e-mail make sure we have your address. It will be sent in that manner in color and save the gallery the cost of postage.

### **Membership Number**

When you join the gallery, you will be assigned a number for identification and this should always appear on your art work sales tag. All art work should be priced to sell if not please put NSF (not for sale).

### **Commissions**

All art work is taken on consignment and a 25% commission is deducted from the payments to artists on the sale of their work. Checks are made out on the first of the month and mailed to the artists.

### **Discounts**

Members receive a 10% discount on frames, mat board, foam core and watercolor paper. These are the only supplies we offer for sale.

### **Mat Cutter**

Available to members, but not to children. With our limited income, it is very difficult to replace any items but especially major equipment.

### **Abandoned Art**

If you do not renew your membership, all art not picked up will be considered a donation to the Gallery at the end of the year.

### **Exhibiting Art Work**

You may hang 3 small, 2 medium or 1 large picture, (22, 32, & 48 inches or less, respectively, in the longest dimension). A committee hangs the show every other month. Wire hangers are required, (no saw tooth hangers). When bringing in new work, please take home your work from the prior showing. We have no place to store them and we will not be responsible for damage.

### **Ceramics and Sculptures**

There are pedestals and shelves available to display your work.

### **Shrink-wrap Machine**

Available to members, but never to children. The cost is 30 cents per lineal foot.

### **Unframed Works**

These must be shrink-wrapped. Only one copy of any print may be displayed at a time. Replace them when they sell. There are bins available for these, but space is limited so be sensitive in how many you bring in or we shall have to weed them out in time.

### **Hosting The Gallery**

Usually we have enough volunteers to keep the gallery open every day (we only close on major holidays). But sometimes we cannot find someone for a particular time. Anyone who would like to help out, either on a regular or fill-in basis, please call Carol Ames or the president. Hosting involves greeting customers and making them feel welcome, making sales, and answering the phone.

### **Fundraising**

At least twice yearly we hold a luncheon & silent auction to raise funds. In Sept. we have our annual Salmon luncheon. You will be called upon to help in various ways at this very special event.

### **Library**

We have a wonderful library of teaching books in every medium. These may be checked out for a two week period. Also available are videos that can be viewed at the gallery (even better, watch them when you are hosting the gallery). These videos cannot be checked out, but videos produced by the Gallery can be checked out.
